- 5. All the citations should be furnished in the Works Cited section at the end of the paper.
- 6. An early submission of the full paper for publication will be highly appreciated.
- 7. Papers will be accepted subject to scrutiny and editorial review.
- 8. The presenters may be asked to make revisions, if required, as suggested by the Review Committee. Files sent as PDF, scanned images or other formats will not be accepted.
- 9. All presenters must register by paying full registration fees by 30th November 2022 failing which their papers may not be included in the conference programme.

1. The city is connected to all parts of Maharashtra by rail as well as road.

By Rail: Parbhani railway station is a junction situated on Secunderabad-Manmad section of South Central Railway Zone. Parbhani is connected through rail way to major cities of Maharashtra, such as Aurangabad, Mumbai, Nagpur, Pune and Ajmer. It is also connected to other Indian cities like New Delhi, Ajmer, Hyderabad, Nizamabad, Visakhapatnam and Chennai.
