Guidelines For Paper Submissions:

1. **Abstract:** All submissions should include an abstract of no more than 250 words, summarizing the main arguments and conclusions of the paper.
2. **Length:** Full papers should be between 1,000 and 2,500 words, including footnotes and references.
3. **Formatting:** Papers should be formatted according to the APA (American Psychological Association) style guide. This includes double-spaced text, one-inch margins, and a 12-point Times New Roman font for English. Marathi and Hindi papers should be typed in DV-TTSurekh 14-point or Unicode 12-point
4. **Language:** Papers must be written in English/Hindi/Marathi.
5. **Originality:** Submissions should be original work not previously published elsewhere. Any sources used should be properly cited to avoid plagiarism.
6. **Structure:** Each paper should have a clear structure, including an introduction, main body, and conclusion. Headings and subheadings should be used to guide the reader through the paper.
7. **References:** All references should be included at the end of the paper, formatted according to APA / MLA guidelines.
8. **Biographical Note:** Please include a short biographical note, including your institutional affiliation, address and contact number.
9. **Submission:** Papers should be submitted as Word documents to the designated email address by the deadline stated.

How to Reach Parbhani:

Parbhani is a city in the state of Maharashtra, India. To reach Parbhani, you have several options depending on your starting location. Here's how you can get there:

By Air:

The nearest airports to Parbhani are:

1. Nanded Airport (Shri Guru Gobind Singh Ji Airport - NDC), around 60-70 km from Parbhani. After landing in Nanded, you can hire a taxi or take a bus to Parbhani. The journey takes approximately 1.5 to 2 hours.
2. Aurangabad Airport (IXU), which is around 190 km away. From Aurangabad, you can reach Parbhani by train, bus, or taxi.

By Train:

Parbhani has its own railway station, **Parbhani Junction (PBN)**, which is well-connected to major cities like Mumbai, Pune, Hyderabad, Nagpur, and Nanded.

- If you're coming from Nanded (Nanded Railway Station - NED), multiple trains are available for Parbhani as it lies on the same railway route. The travel time by train between Nanded and Parbhani is approximately 1 hour.

By Road:

1. From Nanded: Parbhani is well-connected to Nanded by NH 161. You can take a state transport bus, private bus, or a shared taxi. The travel time by road is about 1.5 to 2 hours.
2. From Other Cities:
 - Aurangabad: ~190 km, travel time ~4-5 hours.
 - Hyderabad: ~350 km, travel time ~8 hours.
 - Pune: ~400 km, travel time ~8-9 hours.

Private vehicles, MSRTC buses, and private luxury buses also operate from nearby cities to Parbhani.
