Revised Guidelines for Paper Submissions

- 1. **Abstract:** Submit an abstract of no more than 250 words summarizing the main arguments and conclusions of the paper.
- 2. **Length:** Full papers should be between 1,000 and 2,500 words, including references and footnotes.
- 3. **Formatting:** Use MLA style guidelines with double-spaced text, one-inch margins, and 12-point Times New Roman font.
- 4. Language: Papers can be written in English, Hindi, or Marathi.
- 5. **Originality:** Submissions must be original and not published elsewhere. Proper citations are required to avoid plagiarism.
- 6. **Structure:** Papers should have a clear structure, including an **introduction**, **main body**, and **conclusion**. Use headings and subheadings for better readability.
- 7. **References:** Include all references at the end of the paper, formatted as per MLA guidelines.
- 8. **Biographical Note:** Provide a short biographical note with your **institutional affiliation**, **address**, and **contact number**.
- 9. **Submission:** Submit your paper as a Word document to the designated email address by the stated deadline.
- 10. **Review Process:** All submissions will undergo a peer-review process, and feedback will be provided within 6-8 days of submission.
